Fasting for Finder's Feast

We want to prepare our hearts and anticipate the powerful things God will do through the launch of our new outreach program, *Finder's Feast*.

Therefore, we are calling the church body to a week of prayer and fasting. Between January 27 and February 3 we encourage you to select a fasting practice appropriate for you, giving something up in order to seek God. (Some examples of things you might fast from: meals, specific foods or drinks, social media, screen time, music.)

We especially want to pray for Finder's Feast in these ways: that many people from beyond our church would come enter into community, that God would prepare our hearts to lovingly embrace the people He will draw to our church, that the right leaders will step forward into service roles.

We encourage you to also attend a special night of prayer on January 30, as we pray especially for the launch of Finder's Feast on February 6.
